The focus is not on Via de Cristo itself, but on building up the community of believers. The objective of the movement is to inspire, challenge and equip Christians to be disciples of Jesus Christ.

Is this Right for Me?

- Via de Cristo weekends are to renew, strengthen and inform the faith of Christians. Even long-time Christians to grow in faith and gain inspiration through participating.
- The weekend is a structured, 'shortcourse' in Christianity that provides the Holy Spirit an opportunity to teach us Christ's Way. Many have said the weekend is more effective than years of bible studies and worship attendance.
- This weekend is not to convert you or anyone to Christianity, or any particular issue. Controversial issues are not addressed.
